



Compliance with Regulation (EU) 2024/2847 – Cyber Resilience Act (CRA)

Unitronics hereby confirms that all Unitronics products are CE-marked and meet the applicable European requirements for safety and performance.

Under Regulation (EU) 2024/2847 – the Cyber Resilience Act (CRA), our products are classified as:

“Products with digital elements – non-critical.”

Accordingly, the applicable conformity assessment procedure is based on internal control (self-declaration) as defined in Article 24(2) of the Regulation.

Unitronics is actively implementing the actions necessary to ensure full compliance with the essential cybersecurity requirements set out in Annex I of Regulation (EU) 2024/2847 and to integrate them into our product development and quality management systems.

Unitronics acknowledges that mandatory vulnerability and incident reporting obligations under the CRA apply as of **11 September 2026**, and has established internal processes to identify, assess, mitigate, and report relevant cybersecurity vulnerabilities and actively exploited incidents within the timelines defined by the Regulation.

Full compliance with all applicable CRA requirements, including conformity assessment and CE marking under the Cyber Resilience Act, will be ensured for all relevant products placed on the EU market from **11 December 2027** onward.
